When deciding what to donate, here are some helpful hints: household items such as paper towels, toilet paper, and dish detergent are not eligible for purchase with a Link card; consider pop-top lids as sometimes people do not have a can opener; olive oil, garlic, salt, pepper and other spices can transform a meal; remember items like Hamburger Helper are only good if you have ground beef; baking mixes that require only water are better; coffee is a luxury; sugar and flour are always needed; Kraft Mac and Cheese requires milk and butter, consider Velveeta that comes with the sauce.
