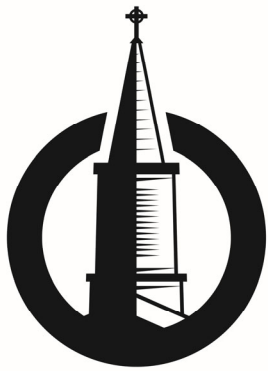
CLASSES FOR ALL AGES
